Moretonville Team Coach Compliance 2023/24 Season

At Moretonville Junior Football Club we take safeguarding very seriously; it is our number one priority. Our coaches are the most important point of contact for young people; therefore, our coaches must meet the FA requirements, before they can be involved in coaching the children.

All coaches at Moretonville Junior Football Club must hold the following:

- An in-date **FA DBS**
- An **FA coaching** qualification (EE Playmaker as a minimum)
- **The FA Safeguarding Children** qualification

No volunteer is permitted to coach any children without holding the above 3 qualifications and these must be in date.

In every team at least 1 person must have completed the following:

- **FA Introduction to Coaching Football Qualification**
- **FA Introduction to First Aid in Football**

How do I login:

You will need to login using the email address that is on your FAN and the associated password.

These **qualifications must be FA accredited** and therefore any of the above criteria that is achieved through work or other groups do not meet the FA requirements.

All accredited course costs will be reimbursed by the club once the training and DBS checks are fully completed. Please email your expense form to finance@moretonville.org.uk

How do I become compliant?

DBS

This is the first thing you must do. To begin the process please email our Club Secretary Linda Woodham:secretary@moretonville.org.uk. The process is then overseen by our CWO Amanda cwo@moretonville.org.uk

FA Safeguarding

This is a mandatory FA Safeguarding children course that every coach must take. It is an online course taking about 3 hours which can be completed in your own time. Cost is £30, but again is refunded by the club.

Coaching Qualifications

The starting point and minimum requirement is The FA EE Playmaker. It is a free online course taking about 3 hours which can be completed in your own time by returning to it when you have time. Free online course

Every team must have a coach that has the following:

- **Introduction to Coaching Football accreditation** (old Level 1) This is again an online course and follows national cohorts over a 4-week period, you have 12 months to complete. Cost is £100.
